8. All Dollar General locations will open from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. for senior shoppers.
9. All Target locations will open on Wednesdays from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. for senior shoppers.
10. All Northgate Market locations will open from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. for seniors and shoppers with disabilities.
11. All Cardenas Markets locations will open on Wednesdays from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. for seniors, caregivers, individuals with disabilities and first responders.
12. All Ralphs locations will open from 7 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. for seniors.
13. All Vons and Albertsons locations will open on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. for senior customers.
14. All Stater Bros. locations will open at 7:45 a.m. for customers who are 65 and over. Please note that this is a 15-minute window before the normal hours of operation.
15. All Baron's Market locations will open between 9 a.m. and 10 a.m. for customers who are 65 and over, individuals with disabilities and pregnant women.
16. All Walmart locations will host an hour-long senior shopping event every Tuesday for seniors who are 60 and over. This will start one hour before the store opens.
